ASK A NEIGHBOR: How long have you lived here?	Attend an event hosted by the City of Fort Wayne.	Ask a neighbor for help with something.	Spend time on your front porch/front yard.	Help with a neighborhood public green space: weeds, clean-up, etc.
Visit any Fort Wayne library branch.	Introduce yourself to someone who has recently moved into the neighborhood.	Invite a neighbor to co-host a neighbor gathering.	Ask a neighbor a question.	Look up your house's history on the neighborhood website.
ASK A NEIGHBOR: What's your favorite thing about our neighborhood?	Learn the names of two neighbors you didn't already know.	Go for a walk through the neighborhood.	Spend time in a neighborhood public space.	Work with your neighbors to create an emergency contact list or exchange numbers.
Find 5 of the 2024 Native Gardens that were planted. *Hint: Look for the small circle signs.	Attend a quarterly neighborhood meeting.	Offer to help a neighbor with something they are working on.	Learn the names of two pets in the neighborhood that you don't already know.	Report an "out" street lamp to 311.
Make something for a neighbor (baked goods, art, etc).	Find/visit one of the two free little libraries in the neighborhood.	Nominate a neighbor for the "Good Neighbor" recognition program	Take a walk and find both of the "secret sidewalks" connecting Seminole Circle/Cornell Circle	Wave at a neighbor.

Complete a BINGO (vertical, horizontal, or diagonal or MORE) and return to your At Large Zone Captain or at a quarterly Neighborhood meeting. Everyone who returns a completed BINGO card will receive spring bulbs to plant in your front yard/easement this fall.
